



What is the Inside Out Project?

It is a project set up by three local charities to assist offenders and their families who have accommodation and debt issues in Exeter, East or Mid Devon

It is run by St Petrocks, CARDPORCH and Homemaker Southwest

Who is the Inside Out Project for ?

- Persistent Offenders
- Prisoners serving a sentence of less than 12 months
- Offenders returning to the areas shown who are homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Families of the above who are homeless or at risk of homelessness or need debt advice

What can the Inside Out Project do for you ?

- Advice and advocacy for you or your family to help maintain your tenancy whilst you are in custody
- Help you to find accommodation prior to release from custody
- Advice and advocacy if you're experiencing problems with your accommodation
- Advice and advocacy to deal with debt or benefit issues

How to apply

- If you are currently in prison please notify the Housing Officer who will complete a general application form with you
- If you are an Offender in the community please speak to a CARDPORCH worker.
- If you are the partner of an offender who fits the criteria for Inside Out please contact Homemaker Southwest
