Alphington has a wealth of wonderful community buildings that each provide something unique and special. The Alphington British Legion situated in Legion Way has long been the home of a local darts team and a skittles league. It regularly hosts live music and events such as the upcoming children's Christmas party and a New Years Eve party. It has access to sky TV and therefore members are able to watch a number of different sports on the large television screens. There are dart boards, fruit machines and a pool table. Each Monday they host bingo which is open to all. There is a small car park and some outdoor seating for the warmer months.

This was a collaboration between the Alphington Community Association and Love Food CIC and a celebration of everything apple! The first Alphington Apple Juice which included the apples from Alphington Primary School, donations from residents of Alphington and the fruits of a fabulous apple picking day at West Town Farm, were squeezed and bottled at Little Bowhay in Shillingford. The Alphington Apple Juice is now available for sale at £3.50 a bottle and all profit made will be reinvested in community projects by the Alphington Community Association.

There has been so much wonderful feedback about the Apple Day. There was an opportunity to try your hand at creating your own apple juice using the apple juicer. There was a fabulous storyteller, face painting and apple printing. There was a scavenger hunt and apple based colouring available. It would not be an event in Alphington without the necessary tea and homemade cakes. A huge thank you to the Alphington Community Association for hosting such a wonderful event and to Maresa from Love Food CIC, who helped co-ordinate the apple picking, the juicing and host the Apple Day.


